

2018 ST. PATRICK'S PARADE
RULES & GUIDELINES FOR ENTRY
\$60 entry fee per entry

1. Line up begins at 9 am on Telfair street. Entry numbers are placed along the roadside. Please make sure that you are in the correct spot by 9am. Please stay in line in your designated spot. Displaced entries result in confusion and errors for media broadcast.
2. Entries must be decorated. The entry should adhere to the theme and be tastefully decorated, including creativity and originality. You must indicate on your application if you want your entry to be judged
3. Please make sure that all your riders know your line up #, for the parade marshals to assist with the correct line up space.
4. Throwing candy or any other items is prohibited. This is a safety issue and is authorized by the City of Dublin. No items can be thrown from vehicles in parade. Any entry with participants throwing items will be removed from the parade by the parade organizer for the City of Dublin Police Department. Walking or distributing candy from the sidelines is permitted. Parade participant may not jump onto or off any float or moving vehicle during the parade.
5. Drivers of all vehicles or equipment in the parade must have a valid driver's license and be at least 18 years of age. All motorized vehicles and motorcycles must have proof of liability insurance and readily available upon request.
Drivers of vehicles or equipment will not be allowed to do tricks or perform any maneuvers that may endanger themselves or others in the parade or along the parade route.
6. Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on any float, in any vehicle, or on the person of any participant. Participants consuming alcohol prior to or during the parade may be removed from the lineup.
7. Horse and riders are welcome in the parade; however, all horses must use poop bags.
8. All pets in the parade must be kept on leashes and held by someone strong enough to manage them. Animals participating in the parade must be kept under control. Entries involving animals of any kind must provide their own clean-up, or "pooper-scooper" immediately following their entry.
9. All entries, including marching bands, must move forward at all times along the parade route. Failure to comply will lead to removal from the parade. Unless pre-approved and arranged by the parade officials, entries must not slow from the parade pace along the "on-camera" areas nor stop for media interviews.
10. No person shall ride on the exterior of an automobile during a parade, except that one person may ride on the back of a convertible automobile.
